When you arrive in Lund

When you arrive in Lund, you should proceed to the Lundaspelen registry. This applies to all participating teams in the tournament.

The tournament registry is located at Eoshallen, Arkivgatan 32, 223 59 Lund, telephone +46 46 15 94 94. During the entire Lundaspelen, registry and hall managers will give you the information you need and answer your questions.

If you let us know at what time you arrive in Lund, we will do our best to meet and transport you to the tournament registry and to your quarters as soon as possible.

Guest cards

Owners of a guest card are entitled to the following:

- Food, lodging and free bus travel with Stadstrafiken Lund on regular routes.
- Free entries to Lundaspelen's own disco and to Källbybadet (Högevallsbadet is undergoing reconstructions and will be open again for the tournament in 2013).

If you lose your guest card, you may buy a new one at a cost of 750 SEK the second day and 500 SEK the third day.

Dining halls/color on guest cards

You have to show your guest card when you enter a dining hall. Leaders are responsible for their players respecting meal times and at the end of meals, returning their trays. Food and beverages must be kept in the dining halls!

Regulations

The tournament committee has the right to expel teams which do not follow the regulations.

General

- 1 Littering is forbidden. Use wastebaskets and trash bags. Keep everything neat and clean. Use the available cleaners. For your own safety, keep doors and windows closed.
- 2 It is absolutely forbidden to drink alcoholic beverages. Smoking is not permitted in buildings.
- 3 Don't leave valuables at your living quarters. Organizers take no responsibility for lost items.
- 4 Clubs are financially responsible for damages. The deposit fee will be refunded when cleaning is approved. Lodging must be left latest the 5th, 10.00.
- 5 Every leader is responsible for his Group's behavior and decides when his or her young people should be in. Anyone out after 11 PM is requested to be quiet upon returning to the living quarters and to lay down without turning on the lights.
- 6 Participants must follow instructions and orders from Lundaspelen officials.

On buses

- 1 Consider that during Lundaspelen, 4,000 persons will be adding stress to bus traffic. Act friendly toward regular passengers and drivers or in other words, behave like "basketball people".
- 2 Ordinary travelers have priority. Don't use your guest card for short trips. Guest cards must be shown when you get on the bus.
- 3 Smoking is forbidden.
- 4 The maximum Group size is 15 persons. The driver's orders must be obeyed.

Rules

- ✓ 3 on 3, a maximum of 6 players/team.
- Players participating in the regular tournament aren't allowed to participate.
- Playing time is probably 12 min/game.
- The teams call the games (fair game principle).
- Coaches/referees who don't have a team to play with are welcome. You will then play with other "free agents".



Tournament rules

Classifications

Players must be **eligble** to play for the club according to own national governing rules (licensing, etc.). Regional differences from national rule do not apply. Age rule is not observed to regional/national differences – players must meet the classification requirements above.

Team rosters should be left no later than 15 minutes before games. If a team has not appeared 5 minutes after a game's starting time, the present team wins. Every player should be able to **prove his/her age** with identification (preferably with a photo). Any team which leaves the court during a game is eliminated from the tournament.

For every court **a game ball** will be provided. Teams must bring their **own basket-balls for warm-up**. Time for warm-up on court will not be guaranteed.

The teams are divided into **Groups with 4–5 teams**, playing **a round-robin**. The two best teams from each group advance to **the A-playoff. Team 3–5 advance to the B-playoff. Both playoffs are** played as a **cup**. If two teams have the same points, the order is decided according to the result between the two teams. **If more than two teams have the same points**, the order is decided according to:

- Results between tied teams:
 a) points
 b) basket difference
 c) baskets made.
- 2 Results from the whole series: a) basket difference b) baskets made.
- 3 Playoff if the placings do not decide advancement.

Game rules

Lundaspelen (U13-U20) is played according to international basketball federation (FIBA) rules, except for the following changes:

- 1 When receiving the 4th personal foul the player has to leave the game. The clock is stopped at the 4th foul. 8th teamfoul in each half penalized. When receiving two technical fouls, the coach may not participate in the next game. 1 timeout per half.
- 2 Substitutions can be made at stop of the game by referee. The referee don't need to hold the ball to stop the game though.
- 3 The 24 second-rule is unobserved. Referees can whistle for deliberate delay tactics, awarding ball to the other team.
- 4 The awayteam changes uniform color if both have the same. If it refuses to change, the home team starts with a 10-0 advantage.
- 5 No jump-balls during regular game-time. Possession arrow applied.
- 6 Categories U20-U13: Play 2x15 min running clock except last 3 min (the clock is also stopped after scoring). Girls play with midi-sized balls (size 6). Boys play with maxi-sized balls (size 7) in the categories BU20-BU15. BU14 & BU13 play with size 6 balls. All kinds of defenses are allowed.
- 7 Regulation ties are decided by an extra 1 x 2 minutes are played until winner is decided.
- 8 Overtime are regarded as prolongings of the 2nd half, which means that team fouls from the 2nd half is used. No timeout is allowed, but if you haven't used the time-out in the 2nd half, you may use it during overtime.

Each overtime period (play-off) starts with an inbound from the team who is entitled to the ball according to the possession arrow. In all jump-ball situations possession arrow is applied. The clock will be stopped at any signal and after scoring.

9 Category U12–U11: Play 6 x 5 minutes running clock. Recrossing the center line is not penalized. Only 2-shot fouls – no bonus rule. No 3-point scoring. Play with mini-sized balls (size 5) and low baskets (260 cm). No zone defense (neither half or full court) is allowed.

Protests & questions

All protests must be written and left with the court-official in the arena no later than 15 minutes after the game. The protest fee is 500 SEK and must be paid when submitting a protest (the fee is refunded if the protest is upheld). The jury's decision cannot be overruled. Members of the tournament jury:

At departure

Before living quarters are left, a Lundaspelen representative must make an official inspection with the leader. COMPULSORY! After cleaning is approved, the deposit fee (500 SEK/team, deposited at check in) is returned by the responsible official.

Luggage help

You can store your luggage at Idrottshallens special area for luggage. IT is NOT allowed to put bags anywhere else for safety and fire safety reasons. Cost is 100 sek/team. Two persons must help to carry – call before 4 pm on 4th of January for booking of bus to take it from your accomodation on the 5th.
