➤ IN 2023

- 2023 was the first ever Watsonia Miniroos Cup
- Mainly focused on 1 age group
- Due to success, looking to expand for 2024
- Over 150 kids played over 80 games across the 10 weeks

FORMAT

➤ HOW IT WORKS

- 10 weeks of games, once per week.
- All teams will play in grading groups within their age groups
- 1st & 2nd will move into the Premier League Groups
- 3rd & 4th will move into the Championship Group
- Teams will play each other twice in the groups to determine Finals
- All teams will playoff for final standings on the last week

➤ DETAILS

- U8 (Born in 2016), 7v7, 20 mins halves
- U9 (Born in 2015), 7v7, 20 mins halves
- U10 (Born in 2014), 9v9, 20 mins halves
- U11 (Born in 2013), 9v9, 20 mins halves
- All players must play in applicable age group based on year of birth
- Regular season size fields and FFV rules
- Players must have played at least 3 games to be eligible for Finals

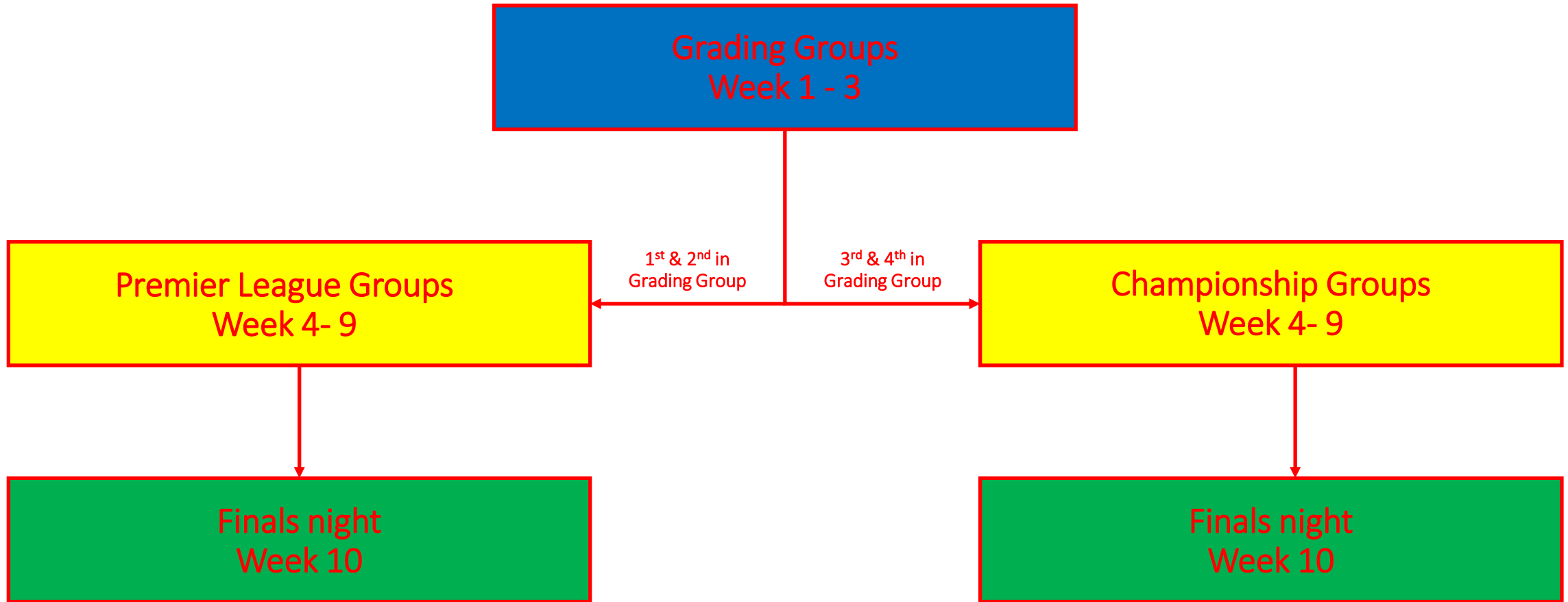




STRUCTURE

➤ TIMES

Games will be played on either Wednesday or Friday nights depending on the number of teams entered to each age group closer to the competition starting

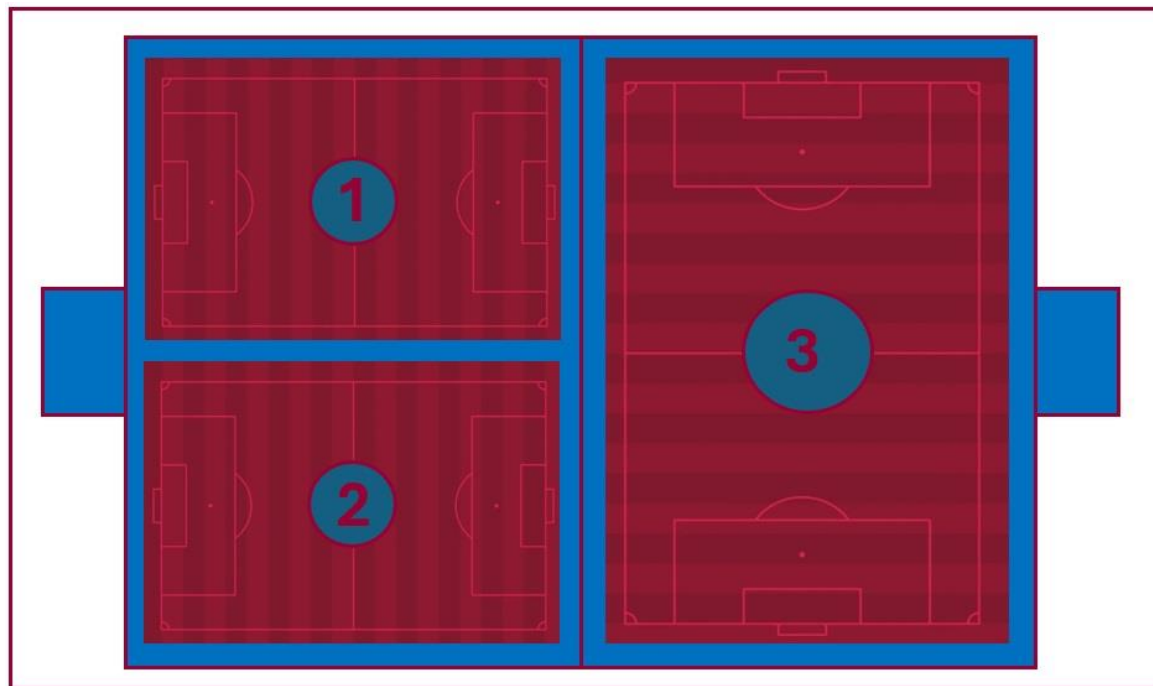
Kick off times will be between 5:30pm-7:45pm and will vary from week to week

EXTRA

➤ WHFC CUP WILL PROVIDE

- Games on NPL level pitch and facilities
- Fixtures, results all uploaded on website.
- Official Referees
- Trophies for Age group Winners
- Medals for Age group Runners Up
- Awards for Golden Boot, MVP and Golden Glove

➤ COSTS

- **Flat \$570 per team** to entry the competition (10 weeks of games)
- U8/U9 teams allowed 12 registered players across the competition
- U10/U11 allowed 15 registered players across the competition
- Player registration required prior to grading game 1
- Players must have played at least 3 grading or group games prior to Finals
