 Teams will play each other twice in the groups to determine Finals

All teams will playoff for final standings on the last week


#### DETAILS

- U8 (Born in 2016), 7v7, 20 mins halves
- U9 (Born in 2015), 7v7, 20 mins halves
- U10 (Born in 2014), 9v9, 20 mins halves
- U11 (Born in 2013), 9v9, 20 mins halves
- All players must play in applicable age group based on year of birth
- Regular season size fields and FFV rules
- Players must have played at least 3 games to be eligible for Finals

Subject to change depending on the number of registered teams






#### > TIMES
