

Amager Mini Cup

Players: There is no maximum number of players in the tournament, but maximum 12 players per. match. Note that there are only 12 medals per temp.

A player who plays as quarter-player (born the last three month of the year before) can only play on one team during the Cup.

Rules: The game is played by the Danish Basketball Federations children rules with the following changes:

U9 (born in 2011-12):

- The game is played 4 * 6 min. running clock, except for the last 2 minutes of the fourth period.
- When receiving the 5th personal foul the player has to leave the game.
- Full court defence only allowed the last 2 minutes of the fourth period and in overtime period.
- If both coaches agrees games on the big courts may be played 5 against 5.



U11 (born in 2009-10):

- The game is played 4 * 7 min. running clock, except for the last 2 minutes of the fourth period.
- When receiving the 5th personal foul the player has to leave the game.
- Full court defence only allowed the last 2 minutes of the fourth period and in overtime period.
- If both coaches agrees games on the big courts may be played 5 against 5.

U13 (born 2007-08):

- The game is played as 2 * 15 min. running clock, except for the last 2 minutes of the second half.
- The games are played with size 6 basketball.
- The game is played as 5 vs 5 player. Substitutions may be made at any time (When ball is out of bounds).
- The time is stopped only by Time-Out (not free throw).
- When receiving the 4th personal foul a player has to leave the game.
- Penalties shoot is awarded on 6th team foul.
- Personal and team fouls are carried over from the second half into overtime.
- 1 timeout per. half (I.e. max. 2 timeouts per. match).
- Full court press is allowed (not allowed if a team is up by +20 points).

Common rules:

- Max. 3-minute break between periods and half time.
- Group matches can end tied.
- Playoff matches will in case of a tie, be decided by a 2-minute overtime, starting with "jump ball". Is the match still undecided, it will go into sudden death, again starting with "jump ball". There is NO time outs in overtime / sudden death.
- Protests must be submitted no later than 10 minutes after the game, along with protest fee of 500, - (to be paid back if successful).
- Team rosters should be submitted no later than 10 minutes before start of a game.



Other rules follow the Danish Basketball Federations children rules.

Standings Group Play:

If more than two teams have the same points, the order is decided according to: 1. Results between tied teams, 2. Score difference, 3. Points made, 4. By lottery.

Uniforms: "home team" (first mentioned team in the program) plays in white/bright uniforms and "Away" in dark uniforms, unless the teams mutually agree otherwise.
